Welcome to Arf and Running Agility Club's NADAC trial. Thank you for attending!! We hope to have a wonderful, fun trial. Please read the rules & information listed below.

Trial Policies and Information

FEES/ENTRY:

- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, smoke, an act of God, public emergency, an act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- There will be no refunds for entries in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition regardless of the reason for such dismissal. A withdrawal from the competition after the closing date due to an injury and/or illness and/or a bitch coming into season after the closing date will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of the total entry fee paid.
- Non-Jumping Classes—Veteran or Disabled Handler. Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in the non-jumping classes only. The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course.
- When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4" lower than your Proficient, Standard Division jump height requires. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.
- **NOTE:** As of January 1st 2009, when entering the Skilled Category, all dogs must jump 4" lower than their Proficient category standard division jump height. (Skilled jump height break is no longer optional)
- Please include your height card with your entry if you have one. If entering your dog in Skilled then there is no need for the dog to be measured or to include the height card.

IMPORTANT: Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the files section of the NADACAgility@yahoogleroups.com list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the www.NADACAgility@yahoogleroups.com list and set your settings to "no mail". You will be able to view trial results and check for any possible discrepancies, without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

TRIAL/SITE:

- All dogs for a given class should be present at ring side at least one-half hour prior to the start of the scheduled classes for walk through and briefing. Any dog and handler not present when they are called will be ineligible to run and the next dog & handler in line will be allowed to run.
- There will be no same day move-ups; however, if you title on Friday/Saturday, you may move up to the next level on Saturday/Sunday. Move-up forms will be available at our hospitality table (or see show secretary). Completed forms must be in the designated place at the end of each trial day.
- Flat Ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth places in all jump heights in all classes except for Chances. Chances class is pass/fail only so there are no placement ribbons. Qualifying Flat Ribbons will be awarded for those achieving a qualifying score. Rosettes will be awarded for those finishing a title and NATCH ribbons/rosette and a jump bar will be presented to those completing a NATCH at this trial.
- **NO AGGRESSIVE DOGS OR PEOPLE ARE ALLOWED.** This trial is to have fun with your dogs and enjoy the sport of agility.
- All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring. Under no circumstance should a dog be tied to anything and left unattended. Remember to clean up after your dog so that we can use these grounds in the future.

FOOD: There will be food concessions on site during the trial. We will send an email out at a later date with specifics.

RAFFLE: There will be a raffle. Proceeds will be used to purchase additional trial equipment for the club.

AGREEMENT

Must be signed and accompany all entries

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1. As used here 'NADAC' means North American Dog Agility Council, Inc., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2. Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC, and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5. Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (including NADAC officers, directors, employees, and members), Arf and Running Agility Club (including its officers, directors, and members, and event organizing committee), the Lewis & Clark County Fairgrounds (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
- 1.6. Exhibitor understands there is a returned check fee of \$15.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of the trial. Dogs must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. Pending numbers are no longer accepted. You can register your dog online at www.nadac.com and receive a registration number immediately. The Current Jump Height Table, Breed Exemption List, description of classes, levels, and divisions are included in the current Exhibitors Handbook. Thru submission of entry, exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules in the current Exhibitors Handbook. I/We further agree that I/We have read, understand, and acknowledge the Agreement printed in this premium and agree to be bound by the "Agreement" printed on this form.

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL

Lewis and Clark County Fairgrounds – Multi Purpose Building 98 West Custer Ave, Helena, MT

From the West: Hwy 12 (Missoula) Hwy 12 West turns into Euclid Avenue as you enter the west end of Helena. At the Henderson Street light, turn LEFT and proceed north on Henderson. Just past the railroad underpass the L&C County Fairground will be straight ahead of you, at the corner of Henderson St. and Custer Avenue.

From the East: Hwy 287 (from Bozeman/Townsend): Follow Highway 12 East into Helena. Just past Wal-Mart, stay in right lane and turn RIGHT to proceed NORTH on I-15 to next exit (Exit 193, Cedar Street). At the end of the ramp, proceed STRAIGHT through the light onto Washington Street. At the stoplight at the intersection of Washington St and Custer Ave, turn LEFT onto Custer Ave. Proceed STRAIGHT on Custer Ave approx. 2.4 miles. At the intersection of Custer Ave and Henderson St (three way stop), turn RIGHT into L&C County Fairgrounds.

From I-15 North (from Butte/Boulder): Go to Exit 193 (Cedar Street). At the end of the ramp, proceed STRAIGHT through the light onto Washington Street. At the stoplight at the intersection of Washington St and Custer Ave, turn LEFT onto Custer Ave. Proceed STRAIGHT on Custer Ave approx. 2.4 miles. At the intersection of Custer Ave and Henderson St, turn RIGHT into L&C County Fairgrounds.

From I-15 South (from Great Falls): Go to Exit 193 (Cedar Street). At the top of the ramp, turn LEFT. At the next stoplight, turn LEFT onto Washington Street. At the stoplight at the intersection of Washington St and Custer Ave, turn LEFT onto Custer Ave. Proceed STRAIGHT on Custer Ave approx. 2.4 miles. At the intersection of Custer Ave and Henderson St, turn RIGHT into L&C County Fairgrounds.
